MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING: May 11, 2021.

CALL TO ORDER: 6:30 p.m. in the Civic Center by Roy Bloom, Chair.

ATTENDANCE: Roy Bloom, Chair; Chris Elkins, Supervisor; Jeff Hurula, Supervisor; Diane Gehr, Treasurer; Andy Tuttle, Clerk; Mark Jerome, Public Works Director; Three member of the public.

MINUTES: Motion by Elkins, second by Hurula to approve the minutes of the April 20, 2021 and May 3, 2021 town board meetings. **CARRIED.**

TREASURER'S REPORT: Gehr reported the following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$190,555.03, Savings \$354.36, Tax savings \$494,735.11, and LGIP \$124,874.88.

ROAD REPORT: Jerome reported:

- Wilkinson Rd. is being prepped for new gravel.
- Memorial benches are \$420 a piece. The board discussed getting 4 benches up to \$2500.

AIRPORT MEETING: Hurula gave an update of the last meeting.

PARK UPDATE: The Park & Rec committee has authorized the 3 large poplars to be cut for \$3000.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

ZONING REQUEST: Mathy Construction is requesting a conditional use permit to operate a temporary asphalt plant in the gravel pit at 47515 US Hwy 63. Diana Randolph expressed concerns and asked the hours of operation be the same as had been in the past and to avoid operation during the Art Tour weekend. Mathy representatives agreed to work within those conditions. Motion by Elkins, second by Hurula to recommend approval to County Zoning with conditions on hours of operation. **CARRIED.**

CHIP SEAL BIDS: Two bids were received. The low bid \$184,481.00 was Scott Construction to chip seal all S. Lake Owen, 2.5 mile N Lake Owen, village streets, parking lots, and Old 63 N Rd. Motion by Elkins, second by Hurula to award the chip seal bid to Scott Construction for \$184,481.00

CRACK FILL BIDS: Jerome requested the crack fill bids be rejected as N. Lake Owen Drive will be ship sealed in 2021 since USFS will pay for a large portion of the project. Motion Elkins, second Hurula to reject the crack fill bids. **CARRIED.**

BILLS: Motion by Elkins, second by Hurula to approve checks #43483 through #43505 including debits and e-pays for payment of bills. **CARRIED.**
