EXTRA TOWN BOARD MEETING: March 16, 2010.

CALL TO ORDER: 7:00 p.m. in the Civic Center.

ATTENDANCE: Bill DeVries, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Mary Behrends, supervisors; Jim Crandall, clerk. 6 townspeople.

The meeting was brought to order by Bill DeVries.

Jim Crandall explained to those present that he is not running again for town clerk in April of 2011. He gave examples of how the offices of clerk and treasurer are structured in other towns. The board and the audience discussed various configurations for the future.

Bill DeVries spoke about the preliminary drawings of ways to develop the approximately 40 acres of land west of Drummond Lake Road. To date nothing has been decided, nor is it the time right to develop it due to economic conditions.

DeVries reviewed that the town board is beginning a process of planning for future equipment and facility needs. Our debt will be retired in 2010. The board would like to accrue funds to put away money, rather than use debt to finance long term purchases. Dale Siebert told of road equipment needs for the future. Mark Jerome spoke about upcoming mandates for fire fighting gear. Roy Bloom spoke about ambulance replacement in the near future, possibly in three years.

It was suggested that these topics be brought before the people at the annual meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
