ANNUAL TOWN MEETING: April 14, 2010

The meeting was called to order in the Civic center at 7:00 p.m. by chairman Bill DeVries. There were 13 residents in attendance.

The minutes of the 2009 annual meeting were available for those present. Motion by Dale Siebert, second by Ryan Fredericks to dispense with reading the minutes and approve them as presented. Carried by a voice vote.

There was general discussion about the town land west of Drummond Lake Road. A preliminary plan for housing was shown. Dick Fredericks spoke about developing a handicapped accessible interpretive trail along the Long Branch creek. Ryan Fredericks presented the chair with a letter signed by 30 townspeople requesting that a campground be developed on the land since the economy does not favor developing building lots at this time. Facilities could be designed for tents and RVs with some sites with electricity. DeVries said the board would look at how this would be created.

Those present discussed whether the next town clerk should be appointed or remain as an elected position. Jim Crandall has stated he would not run for another term as clerk in 2011. The consensus was to publicize the opening in the summer newsletter to see if there is local interest in the office. There was a general feeling that the future office should be appointed by the board, and keeping an elected treasurer.

The clerk reviewed the 2009 annual financial report.

There being no further business for the annual meeting, motion by Doug Manthey, second by Ryan Fredericks to set the 2011 annual meeting for Wednesday, April 13, 2011. Carried by a voice vote.
