MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING: April 14, 2010.

CALL TO ORDER: 8:45 p.m. in the Civic Center. (after the annual meeting)

ATTENDANCE: Bill DeVries, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Mary Behrends, supervisors; Jim Crandall, clerk; Diane Gehr, treasurer. 13 townspeople.

MINUTES: Motion by Behrends, second by Fredericks to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2010 regular board meeting as presented. **CARRIED.**

REPORTS: *Roads* – Dale Siebert, road foreman, said that cost of replacement traffic signs to meet 2012 standards will be paid for by a grant administered by the county. *Airport* – DeVries said the runway will be paved this summer as part of the airport improvement program. *Treasurer* – The following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$60,363.07, savings \$35,362.51, cemetery CDs \$2,044.28, Tax \$92,297.79, LGIP \$172,966.46. Motion to approve the report by Fredericks, second by Behrends. **CARRIED.**

PUBLIC COMMENT: Alan Ralph spoke to the board with a plan for keeping roadsides clean, in lieu of having a single, one-day cleanup in the spring.

SPEED LIMIT: Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to restrict the speed limit on Old 63 North to 45 mph, except where the limit is posted at a lower speed. **CARRIED.**

TOWN PLAN COMMISSION: Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to re-appoint Rodger Larsen and Mary Ann Spears to a three year term on the Town Plan Commission. **CARRIED.**

FIRE CHIEF: Motion by Behrends, second by Fredericks to re-appoint Mark Jerome to a two year term as fire chief. **CARRIED.**

LAKE OWEN PIER: Motion by Behrends, second by Fredericks to purchase a portable dock from Bear Country for \$3,400 for the Lake Owen boat launch area. **CARRIED.** Discussion revealed that the old dock requires extensive work to bring to a state good enough to use fore the site. The board will attempt to sell the old dock.

The board postponed talking about additional street lights in the village.

BUSINESS CENTER: Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to accept the quote by Al Nelson Electric to replace the electrical box at the Drummond Business Center for \$1,400. The motion also included placing the power underground for an additional estimated amount of \$700. **CARRIED.**

BILLS: Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to approve checks #34138-34196 for payment of bills. **CARRIED.**

The next town board meeting is set for May 12, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the Civic Center.

The Annual Roadside clean-up is on Saturday, May 8th.
