MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING: August 11, 2010.

CALL TO ORDER: 7:02 p.m. in the Civic Center.

ATTENDANCE: Bill DeVries, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Mary Behrends, supervisors; Jim Crandall, clerk; Diane Gehr, treasurer. 6 townspeople.

AGENDA: Motion to approve the agenda by Fredericks, second by Behrends.

CARRIED

MINUTES: Motion by Behrends, second by Fredericks to approve the minutes of the July 14, 2010 town board meeting. **CARRIED.**

REPORTS: *Roads* – Dale Siebert reported that the village roads will be chip seal-coated next week. Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to authorize Siebert to install a new header and order a new overhead door for approx. \$3,000 for the bus garage. *Fire Department* - Rodger Larsen reported three responses to false alarms in the past month. *Library* – Fredericks announced a basket weaving demonstration on 8/12 and a Guatemala program to be held at the library. *Airport* – DeVries reported that the runway is being ground up with paving next week. Three towns each contributed 2 days of brushing labor and machinery. The airport will be closed until the first week of September. *Chair* – DeVries reported on correspondence during the month. *Treasurer* – The following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$9,438.91, savings \$35,384.55, cemetery CD \$2,140.74, Tax savings \$77,587.22, LGIP \$173,089.38. Motion to approve by Behrends, second by Fredericks. **CARRIED.**

PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment.

AMBULANCE: Rob Puls, Director of the Great Divide Ambulance service spoke to the board. Great Divide is paramedic licensed, has critical care and flight care certifications and is a model service for the state. In order to hold costs down, the service does hospital-to-hospital transfers to generate additional income. The board thanked Rob for his dedication and hard work toward making the service a first-rate organization.

ZONING: Motion by Behrends, second by Fredericks to approve the request by Greg & Erin Munson to rezone their property located on Tahkodah Lake from F-1 to R-1. **CARRIED.** All the adjacent properties are currently R-1, with this being the only lot not so zoned.

CAMPGROUND: The board discussed how to proceed with plans and development of a campground on the new town land. Fredericks will contact Nelson Surveying to estimate costs.

WEBSITE: The board considered continuing to put the Bottom Line News on the town website. Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to extend publishing the paper on the website until August 2011. CARRIED.

BILLS: Motion by Fredericks, second by Behrends to approve checks #34355-34379 for payment of bills. CARRIED.

The next town board meeting is scheduled for September 8, 2010.
