MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING: August 8, 2017.

CALL TO ORDER: 6:30 p.m. in the Civic Center by Roy Bloom, Chair.

ATTENDANCE: Roy Bloom, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Chris Elkins, Supervisors; Diane Gehr, treasurer; Andy Tuttle, clerk; Mark Jerome, Road Foreman; 1 member of the public.

MINUTES: Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2017 town board meeting with corrections. **CARRIED.**

TREASURER'S REPORT: Gehr reported the following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$144,241.20, savings \$27,901.13, Tax savings \$26,398.38, and LGIP \$175,761.48.

ROAD REPORT: Jerome related several items

- Tri-Lakes Rd. has been repaired
- Holly Lake Rd. chip seal is done. The board discussed whether centerlines were needed. Lines cost about \$6600 to paint. The board chose not to paint lines at this time.
- The campground kiosk was hit again. Mark will get someone to fix it and look into protection measures.
- Visitor Center sign was installed on the library.
- The school is willing to trade the old roof rock for line painting services. The town could use the rock so a trade will be made.
- Mark will be attending WISLR training/workshop.
- The FS delivered the replacement culverts for FR404.
- Mike Pliss' work schedule was adjusted to Tuesday through Friday during the summer. This will allow someone to be available 5 days a week.

AIRPORT REPORT: The FAA is slowly making progress with the sale of land to the gun club.

CAMPGROUND: The showers have made more money so far this year than all of last year and the overall income from the campground is right on target. The campground was completely full for the first time ever in July. The board discussed adding a few tent sites and will consider budgeting for this project. The Drummond Recreation Maps are all gone. The board asked the Park & Rec. Committee to look into getting another batch printed.

SUPERVISOR: Fredericks is interested in attending the WTA training on Sept. 6th at Lakewoods. Tuttle will also try to attend.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Wade Spears spoke to the board about how UDC inspection works from a contractor's point of view.

DBC ROOFING BIDS: Two bids were received to complete the roofing project on the Drummond Business Center. Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to award the roofing contract to Fred Lau Roofing for \$8,800.00. **CARRIED.**

ZONING REQUEST: Richland Club, Inc. is requesting a Class A permit to raze a cabin and replace with new one on a parcel zoned Forestry at 9800 County Hwy. N. Motion by Fredericks, second by Bloom to approve Richland Club, Inc's zoning request. **CARRIED.**

BILLS: Motion by Fredericks, second by Elkins to approve checks #40751 through #40803 including e-pays for payment of bills. **CARRIED.**
