**MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING:** October 10, 2017.

**CALL TO ORDER:** 6:30 p.m. in the Civic Center by Roy Bloom, Chair.

**ATTENDANCE:** Roy Bloom, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Chris Elkins, Supervisors; Diane Gehr, treasurer; Andy Tuttle, clerk; Mark Jerome, Road Foreman; 1 member of the public.

**MINUTES:** Motion by Fredericks, second by Elkins to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2017 town board meeting. **CARRIED.**

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Gehr reported the following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$245,347.23, savings \$27,901.13, Tax savings \$26,398.38, and LGIP \$176,059.25.

**CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:** Bloom spoke with Bremer Bank regarding interest rates on savings accounts. LGIP still has the best interest rate. Bloom also met with the USFS. They discussed road issues and the lack of communication in regards to timber harvesting and repairs as well as the status of the Wildcat Trail.

**ROAD REPORT:** Jerome related several items

- Larsen Road gravel, FR 404 culvert replacement and Lake Owen Dr. crack fill projects are all completed.
- Black top for the FD parking area will be done next week.

**AIRPORT:** The pancake breakfast was well attended with around 30 planes flying in for the event.

**PARK & REC.:** The campground is well exceeding last year's revenues. There are also 2 confirmed seasonal campers.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** There was no public comment.

**RESOLUTION EXEMPTING LIBRARY LEVY:** Motion by Fredericks, second by Elkins to approve the annual resolution to exempting the Town from the County library levy. **CARRIED.**

**EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK:** The board reviewed updates to the employee handbook. A few suggestions were given to the clerk to incorporate into the handbook. The handbook will be addressed at the next meeting.

**BILLS:** Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to approve checks #40858 through #40907 including debits and e-pays for payment of bills. **CARRIED.**

**2018 BUDGET:** The board worked on the 2018 budget

**NEXT MEETING DATE:** The next regular town board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 14, 2017 in the Civic Center immediately following the Budget Hearing and Meeting of Electors.
