**MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING:** June 13, 2017.

**CALL TO ORDER:** 6:30 p.m. in the Civic Center by Roy Bloom, Chair.

**ATTENDANCE:** Roy Bloom, Chair; R. W. Fredericks, Jr., Chris Elkins, Supervisors; Diane Gehr, treasurer; Andy Tuttle, clerk; Mark Jerome, Road Foreman.

**MINUTES:** Motion by Fredericks, second by Elkins to approve the minutes of the May 9, 2017 town board meeting. **CARRIED.**

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Gehr reported the following balances are in town accounts: Checking \$82,900.95, savings \$27,890.70, Tax savings \$266,317.85, and LGIP \$175,518.46.

**ROAD REPORT:** Jerome related several items

- Pigeon Lake boat landing clean up is complete and the Forest Service will be blacktopping it.
- The new lights at the park have been installed.
- The Drummond Lake boat ramp dredging permit is in hand and the project can be planned for this winter.
- Tanya Zangri is now cleaning and scheduling the civic center. The town purchased her a cell phone for scheduling.
- The Cat grader trainer was in town and the crew spent some time grading roads with him.
- The Forest Service has given the go ahead to contract with Fahrner to crack fill Lake Owen Dr. from Porcupine Rd. to the Cable line.

**AIRPORT REPORT:** Another hangar is being planned.

**LIBRARY REPORT:** An estimate was received for the 'visitor center' sign. The library board will discuss funding options.

**PARK & REC COMMITTEE:** An estimate was received for metal ramps at each end of the pavilion. It will cost around \$159 to \$200 for the steel. Dale Siebert also completed the trail he has been working on from the campground.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** There was no public comment.

**ZONING REQUEST:** Due West, LLC requested a zoning permit to construct a residential garage on a lot zoned commercial. The Comp. Plan commission found no issues with the request. Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to recommend approving the permit to the County Zoning Board. **CARRIED.**

**SIGN REQUEST:** John Nachtsheim requested to place a sign on Esox Road honoring Linda Brown for her contribution to the cabin owners on the lake. The board thought a sign on each end of Esox Rd. would be appropriate. The Town will donate the posts and Mark will work with Nachtsheim on design and location.

**OFF-HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLES:** Roy spoke with Dep. Kistner regarding the new laws pertaining to off-highway motorcycles. In short, they are now treated like ATV's. Currently, they can use Forest Service trails but not state, county or town trails. There are very few trails in the area that are open to them. The town agreed to take no action unless a request is made to open trails. The board said it would be open to allowing them from the church to the gas station to the campground.

**DRAG LEVELING BIDS:** One bid from Northwoods Paving was received for the drag leveling project on Lake Owen Drive. Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to award the contract for drag leveling to Northwoods Paving for an amount not to exceed \$53,000.00. CARRIED.

**LIQUOR LICENSES:** Eagle Knob Lodge submitted the only completed liquor license renewal. Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to renew the liquor license for Eagle Knob Lodge. CARRIED.

**OPERATOR/BARTENDER LICENSE:** No applications were received.

**TRAFFIC SIGNAGE:** A request was made to replace the stop sign back at the intersection of Owen Ave. and Superior Street. The board took no action on the matter.

**AIRPORT PROJECTS FUNDING:** The airport commission agreed to a term that if Federal money was used for any project the owners (3 towns) of the airport must sign for every category of funding requirements. The board agreed to sign the required documents.

**CHILDREN'S THEATER PRODUCTION:** The town board typically sponsor's a production of the yearly play produced by the CCT. The board budgeted \$600 and will send the payment to CCT.

**BILLS:** Motion by Elkins, second by Fredericks to approve checks #40635 through #40699 including e-pays for payment of bills. CARRIED.

**FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:** The roof replacement of the Business Center should be put out for bids.

**NEXT MEETING DATE:** The next regular town board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at 6:30 pm in the Civic Center.

Board of Review is scheduled for June 22, 2017 from 3pm to 5pm in the Civic Center. The open book will be held from 1pm to 3pm at the same location and date.
